



MUSEUM OF FINE ARTS

The Museum of Fine Arts, opened in 1906, is reputed to be among Europe's most prominent museums. Its multi-faceted collections and their historical continuity coupled with the large number of masterpieces undoubtedly earn it a prestigious place among public collections.

The Museum of Fine Arts displays the treasures of international and Hungarian art spanning from ancient times to the end of the eighteenth century, while its large-scale temporary exhibitions attract hundreds of thousands of visitors.

The most typical events of the venue:

partner party, conference, gala dinner, press conference, awards and opening ceremony. The venue offers versatile catering, including fingerfood, gala dinners and buffet dinners. Outside catering is also allowed.

MARBLE HALL

The museum's first hall, a representative reception area, is named after its elegant marble covering: the largest hall in size, it was built in neo-Renaissance style to house the large plaster sculptures. The balustraded handrail of the staircase leading upstairs runs along both sides of the hall, its resting area connected to the marble halls like a colonnade gallery, offering a beautiful view of the hall. Mostly a welcome reception venue.



RENAISSANCE HALL

The Renaissance Hall of the Museum of Fine Arts is decorated with a selection of 14th-15th century Italian frescoes from a unique collection of frescoes from all over Europe. Some series have only recently been discovered to have once adorned the walls of churches in Perugia and Bergamo. The Venetian wells on display in the room show the high skill of the local stone carvers, with decorative motifs from the early and late Renaissance.



BAROQUE HALL

This representative hall of the Museum, which was renovated a few years ago to create a palace courtyard within the building, is characterised by the Baroque style of architecture, as originally conceived by the architects. The current state of the hall is an attempt to recreate the atmosphere and somewhat cluttered layout of the former aristocratic collections. The sculptures in the centre of the hall, by their sheer size, make the space a lively place.



ROMANIAN HALL

The Romanian Hall is the space with the richest interior decoration in the Museum of Fine Arts. The space, reminiscent of a Romanesque basilica, is divided by huge columns and pillars. But for seventy years it was closed to visitors. Damaged during the Second World War, the hall was restored between 2015 and 2018.



HUNGARIAN RAILWAY MUSEUM



Following serious efforts which resulted in only partial renovation of the area, Europe's first interactive railway park opened on 14 July 2000. The Museum displays over a hundred railway vehicles and pieces of equipment on an area of over 70,000 m², located on the premises of the former Budapest North Railway Depot.

The unique 34-bay roundhouse built in 1911 houses the historical locomotives, for example the oldest still operational steam locomotive from 1870 and the legendary Árpád railcar from the 1930s (which covered the distance between Budapest and Vienna in 2 hours and 57 minutes). The gem of the vintage fleet is the elegant teakwood dining car built in 1912, which ran in the famous Orient Express that now represents the epitome of luxury of a bygone era.

More than 100 railway vehicle rarities are parked here, among them fifty rare locomotives and other railway vehicles, such as railcars, hand-powered and motorised handcars, an inspection car, steam cranes, snow ploughs and snow blowers and other curiosities, the most beautiful and most valuable ones collected at one place. The exhibits take visitors through the entire history of the railways from the steam engines of the 1870s to the powerful electric engines of today. Many of the vehicles are still operational and are used for nostalgic train journeys organised by MÁV Rail Tours Ltd. both in Hungary and abroad.

POOL AND EVENT COMPLEX



The venue is suitable for a gala dinner for up to 1000 people, but also for smaller events for 200-300 people, as the room can be divided into two sections with a partition curtain, and can be further sectioned if required. The grandstands are not visible for these events, they are covered with black curtains all around, and the sports field is always covered with black ballet carpet, making the hall a homogeneous event venue.

Variable interior spaces, a sufficient number of bathrooms, dressing rooms, VIP room, sound, lighting, projection and stage equipment to meet all requirements, quality furniture, high quality catering service.

In addition to the event hall, other venues can also be hired on request for any event-related event, e.g. car show in front of the buffet, outdoor show, etc.

Additional facilities: women and men shower and toilette.



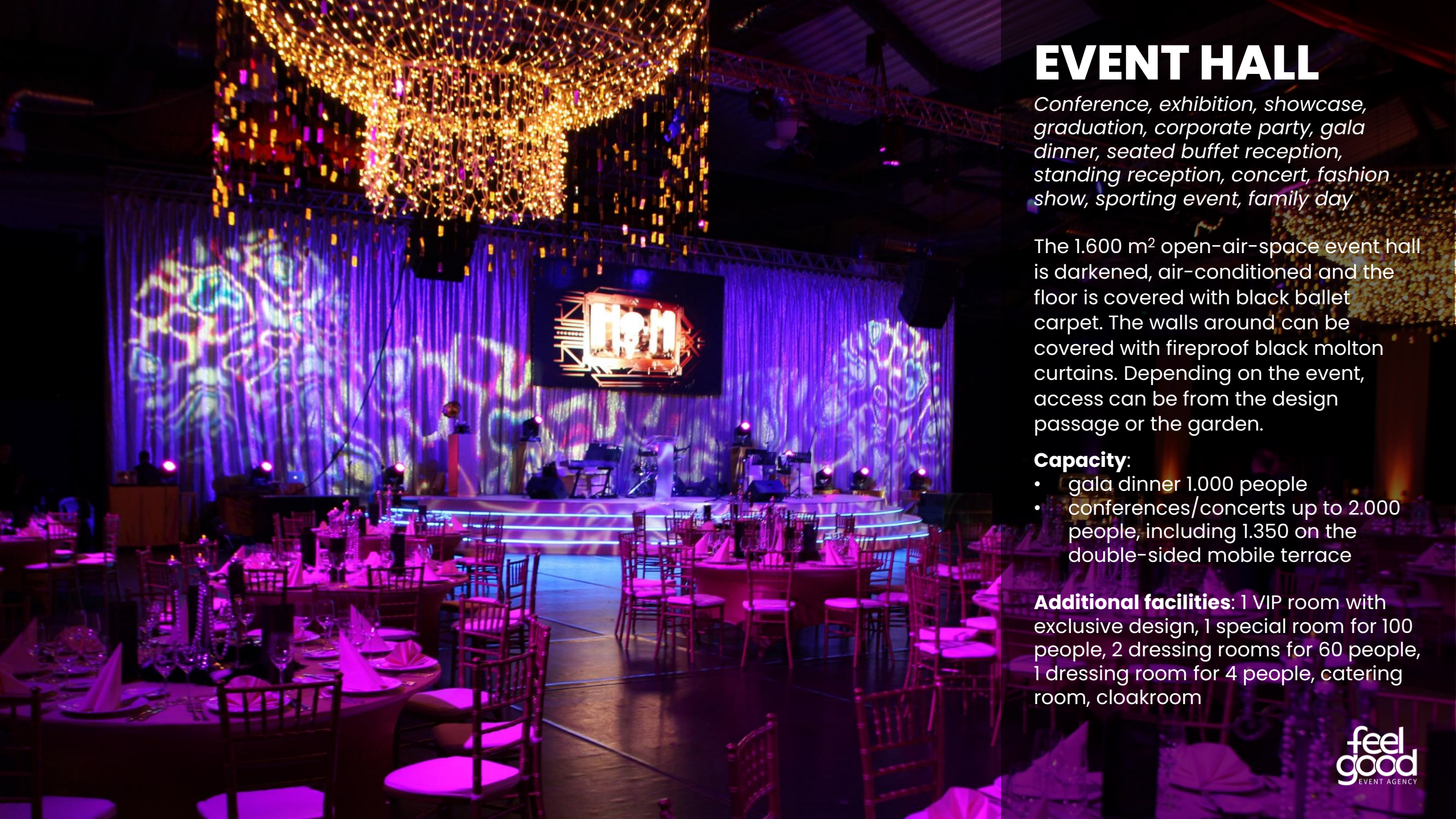
ARTIFICIAL GRASS FOOTBALL PITCH

*Football tournament, family day, team
building, sports competition*

The 40x20 m pitch with artificial turf is open
all year round.

EVENT HALL

Conference, exhibition, showcase, graduation, corporate party, gala dinner, seated buffet reception, standing reception, concert, fashion show, sporting event, family day

The 1.600 m² open-air-space event hall is darkened, air-conditioned and the floor is covered with black ballet carpet. The walls around can be covered with fireproof black molton curtains. Depending on the event, access can be from the design passage or the garden.

Capacity:

- gala dinner 1.000 people
- conferences/concerts up to 2.000 people, including 1.350 on the double-sided mobile terrace

Additional facilities: 1 VIP room with exclusive design, 1 special room for 100 people, 2 dressing rooms for 60 people, 1 dressing room for 4 people, catering room, cloakroom

AREA IN FRONT OF THE BUFFET

Activity, indoor programme, round table discussion, second hinterland

This area can be found directly in front of the entrance of the Event Hall. Depending on the client's request the venue of the event can be enlarged with this 16 sqm size area.

The area is perfect for round table discussions and indoor activities on a family day or for programmes and second hinterland on gala dinners and concerts.



SPECIAL ROOM

Small standing reception, press conference, product launch, VIP room, catering room

There is a direct access to the 130 m² size, air-conditioned room from Csörsz street.

Technical information: integrated sound and projection equipment.

Capacity: 100 - 130 people (depending on the set up)



POOLS

Standing reception, fashion show, lounge party, themed party, water sport competition (outside)

Indoors you can find a 25 m size swimming pool and a teaching pool while outdoors there is a 33 m size swimming pool. The wellness area offers a great relaxation thanks to its 16-person hot tub, two Finnish saunas and a stream bath.

The indoor pool has a 230-seat grandstand, making it the ideal venue for water sports competitions.

Pools can be hired together, in instalments or separately, depending on their availability and the existing contracts.



HARIS PARK

BALLROOM

The Ballroom is 320 m² with a 9 m-high ceiling, and a wealth of natural light. It is air-conditioned with two side-wings.

In the event of a gala dinner, we can provide space for up to 120 guests, or for a standing reception, the capacity is approximately 250 people, or if you want a theatre setting, approximately 200 people can be seated.

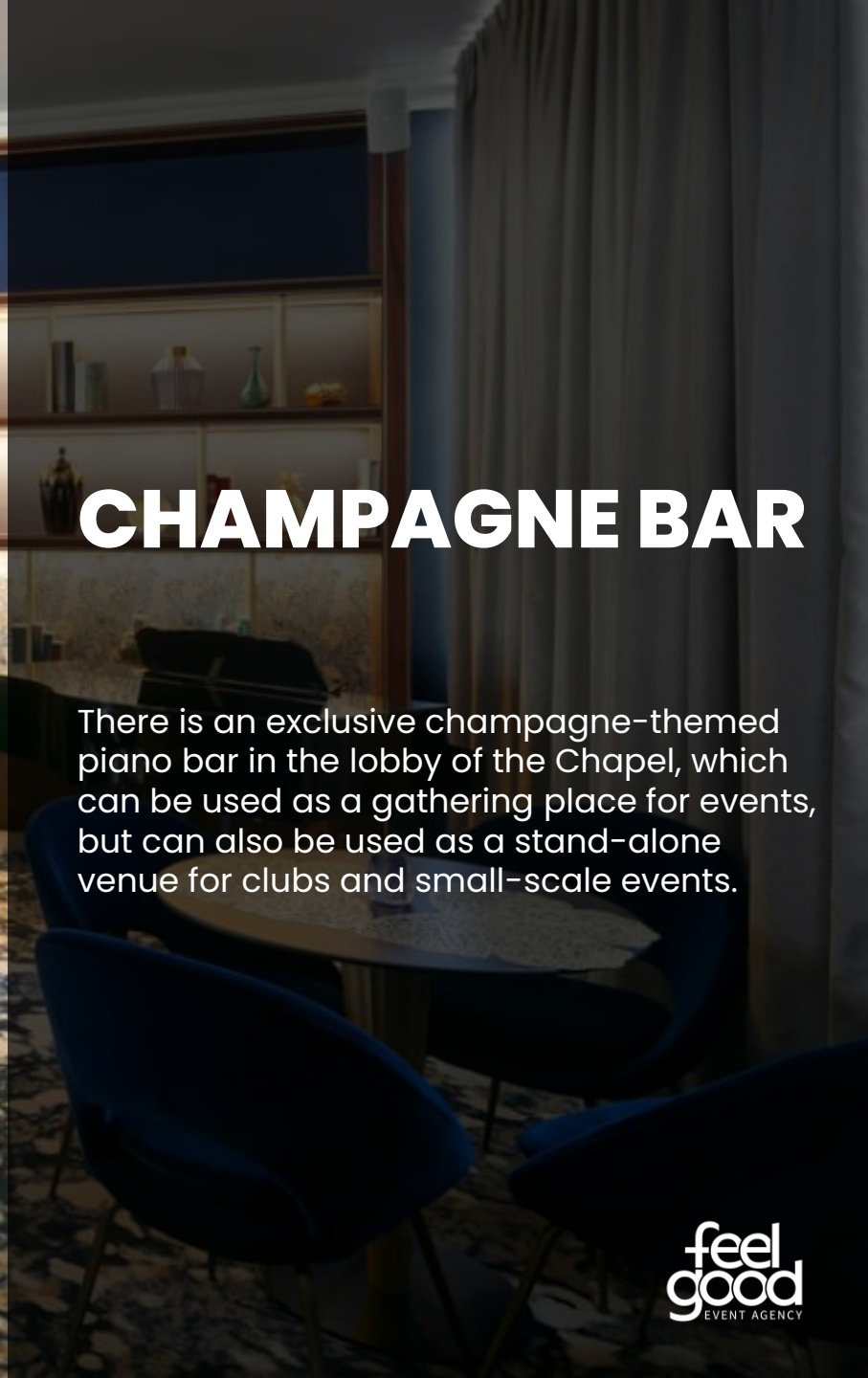




CHAPEL

The Chapel is a 70 m² hall with a gentle, sacred atmosphere which can accommodate 70 people in the case of theatre setup, including a small stage.

The guests can get together and have a nice drink in the similarly-sized Bubbles Bar, which is located adjacently.



CHAMPAGNE BAR

There is an exclusive champagne-themed piano bar in the lobby of the Chapel, which can be used as a gathering place for events, but can also be used as a stand-alone venue for clubs and small-scale events.



GARDEN

Our historic park in front of the monumental building is suitable for organizing outdoor receptions, wedding ceremonies, or smaller garden parties for up to 150 guests.

Here, in Budapest's one-of-a-kind park you will find small pavilions, diverse flora, and professional audio system - in case of unfriendly weather you may use indoor space of equivalent size.



MEETING ROOMS

On the first floor, there is a 70 m² and a 50 m² meeting room, which can be used as a place to meet in groups for business events held in the ballroom, or it can be rented separately.

Both rooms have access to the rooftop terrace.



SUITE

Haris Park has also been called the "one-room hotel". In the tower, there is a 50 m² suite, complete with its own living-room, bedroom and bathroom. It forms a perfect retreat for the newly-married couple, or for the special guest of a business event.

Its balcony has a view to the ballroom, which gives an opportunity for many special attractions.

Bobo Restaurant at Haris Park opened in April 2019, serving traditional flavours of the Austro-Hungarian Monarchy in modern layout – paying homage to history of the building, yet fulfilling 21st century preferences.

THE GOLDEN SALON

The Golden Salon is situated to the left of the 160-year-old café. One of the most beautiful salons in the café, it takes its name from the gold silk wallpaper that covers the walls. The salon, with its central patinated fireplace and imposing mirror, can be separated from the rest of the café by a thick brocade curtain. A prestigious venue for press breakfasts, book launches, gala dinners and ceremonies.

ROYAL RIDING HALL

The rebuilt Royal Riding Hall is one of the most impressive buildings of the Buda Castle, surrounded by the also renovated Csikós Courtyard, which can be an excellent outdoor venue for events.

Upon entering the building, the grand and elegant Royal Riding Hall opens up in front of us, which with its 640 sqm floor area and almost 15-meter high ceiling, can serve as an exceptional venue for large corporate events, conferences, exhibitions, or even balls and weddings. The presidential box on the first floor provides an extraordinary view of the hall, in addition to serving rooms and a bandstand located on this level.

In the basement, there is a cloakroom that is suitable for 300 guests and is also designed to enhance the guest experience. Safe parking is available at the Castle Garage located under the Buda Castle, which is directly connected to the Csikós Courtyard by an elevator. The Royal Riding Hall can accommodate up to 300 guests.
